**Direct Printing into the DOCBOX to a specified Destination
 from a Software Product**

Excerpt from the DOCBOX R&D Documentation

4.4. JobName Mechanism

The specification of the print destination within the print job name works as following. The printing process prints to DocPrPCL and selects a special name for the print job:

! ! XXaaaaXXbbbbXXccccXXddddXXeeeeXXffffXXgggg! ! zzzz...

where

XX is a 2 digit decimal number specifying the number of characters to follow in the next field

aaaa	DestinationDepartment	(with XX characters)
bbbb	DestinationCabinet	(with XX characters)
cccc	DestinationFolder	(with XX characters)
dddd	DestinationJob	(with XX characters)
eeee	Author	(with XX characters)
ffff	SearchCriteria1	(with XX characters)
gggg	SearchCriteria2	(with XX characters)

zzzz...Characters may follow, they are ignored

The string "!!" must be the first 2 characters in the job name and must follow the SearchCriteria2, otherwise, the print job is ignored and moved to PrintSafe.

The given destination is created if not yet existing.

Example:

!!18President's Office08Incoming04199607Private12Bill Clinton18Letter from Monica19Do not tell Hillary!!Everthing from here is ignored...

DestDepartment	18 chars	President's Office
DestCabinet	8 chars	Incoming
DestFolder	4 chars	1996
DestJob	7 chars	Private
Author	12 chars	Bill Clinton
SearchCriteria1	18 chars	Letter from Monica
SearchCriteria2	19 chars	Do not tell Hillary
